## Compost, manure, litter, and soils

### Effects

- Accelerates the action of composting and improves the quality of the resulting compost
- Stimulates the microbial life necessary to the aerobe decomposition of all types of compost, strongly diminishing odors.
- Supplies a steady source of nutrients for plants as the ammonium allies itself with fungus and bacteria.
- Encourages better conditions in farm buildings (less flies).

### Dosage and directions for use

Spraying: 40 g/m<sup>3</sup> of manure/compost, to be mixed with water. Let sit for 1-2 hours. Stir before use.

Dry: 40 g/m<sup>3</sup> of manure/compost, to be mixed with sand, saw dust, or rock powder at 1:10.

On a pile: mix 40g of product/10L water per m<sup>3</sup>. Spread evenly on the compost layers. On an existing pile, make holes and pour in; otherwise, spray when turning over the pile.

Stock farm buildings: the first time, start after having removed the manure/litter or after a sanitary all-in/all-out. Spray the ground and the walls with 3g of product/m<sup>2</sup>. Repeat the application weekly with 2g/m<sup>2</sup>.

Compost bin: sprinkle approximately 60 ml (1/4 cup) of the product when the bin is empty and after each addition. Pre-mix with sand for better distribution.

In the house: daily sprinkle a dash of the product for every liter of peelings in the compost bucket.

Direct application on the soil for composting of crop residues: Spray directly on the fields, the first time: 500 g/Ha, mixed with water. Thereafter, 200g/Ha at the beginning of spring or in the fall.

### Recommendations:

For better results in stock farm buildings, we recommend the use of **Plocher T** for feeding and **Plocher Kat** for revitalizing the water.

### Note:

- The product must be stored in a dry area, on wood. Avoid cement and metal surfaces and the proximity (approx. 5 ft) to the fuse box, electric motors and baseboard heaters.
- During manipulation of large amounts of the product, wearing a mask is recommended.
